

8. LENGTHSMAN SCHEME – Concerns regarding the communication with the Lengthsman and the implementation of the work that was being set out was expressed by all Parish Councillors. It was agreed that such concerns should be shared with the Lengthsman at a meeting to be convened on the 10th December. Further a list of those tasks undertaken and the costings would be drawn up by the Clerk and presented to the next Parish Council meeting together with Cllr Highfield.

9. PLANNING MATTERS - The Clerk reported on the progress of those Planning Applications that had previously been considered by the Parish Council.

10. PLAYING FIELD – A Andrews reported to the meeting that a report had been received in respect of the local playing field. That report is being shared with the Lengthsman as it outlines works to be undertaken to bring it into line with the report. Further consideration should be given to the putting together of grants for signs and furniture within the playing field.

11. HIGHWAY MATTERS – Those issues relating to flooding had already been dealt with earlier in the meeting. Cllr Highfield reminded Parish Councillors that any concerns relating to concerns about pot holes should be detailed on the relevant pot hole site set for that purpose.

12. PARISH COUNCIL WEBSITE –It was agreed that the website had shown considerable improvements. Agenda and Minutes were being posted along with material provided by the War Memorial Committee.

13. DEFIBRILLATOR – Investigations are being conducted into the setting up of a defibrillator to be provided within the telephone box in Monnington on Wye. Clearly for such a process to be pursued finances will have to be sought from within the area.

14. FOOTPATHS – Mr Shepherd has walked and liaised with Cllr Highfield on a regular basis. Consideration is being given to the replacement of bridges and stiles here appropriate. Such equipment is available. Training sessions are to be made available for Footpath Officers.

15. WAR MEMORIAL – A report was received from B Arthur outlining the latest developments. The meeting was informed that a Section 38 for the use of common land and the placement of the memorial at the Doctors Pool had been agreed. Fund Raising will commence at the end of January. The Chairman stated, on behalf of the Parish Council, that body would assist in any way that may be required.
